The Merit Badge class will begin promptly at 8:15 a.m. Light snacks will be provided. Please bring extra light snacks and liquids if so desired. Following the class portion you will ride the METRO L (Gold) Line from the South Pasadena Station to the Del Mar Station in Pasadena to see an early Santa Fe Depot and experience, first-hand, rail safety. Upon completing the (L) Gold Line ride, you will return to the South Pasadena Station and receive the signing of your “blue” card by LARHF’s Merit Badge counselors.

Be sure you bring the filled-out “blue card” and writing materials. Class information and preparation videos will be emailed to you once you return this registration form and your \$35.00 fee.

- **Each Scout/Troop must provide transportation from LARHF HQ to South Pasadena Station.** The drive is approximately 15 minutes long, with free street parking near the station.
- Scout Guardians are invited to stay at LARHF HQ during the class, or feel free to explore restaurants/coffee shops in Eagle Rock, CA.
